4 **Report from County & District Councillors:**

**County Cllr Thomas** informed the council that Norfolk and Suffolk NHS Foundation Trust (Mental Health) has decided that female patients only will be treated in Norfolk; men will have to travel to Ipswich. The Morningthorpe Recycling Centre now has improved signage to ease the traffic issues at the site. The Nutrient Neutrality issue, along with increased tarmac costs, is having an effect on the Long Stratton bypass.

**District Cllr Edney** informed the council that he has left the Conservative group on the District Council and is now an independent councillor. He is looking into funding from his member's grant for trees for this council, or he will inform us and let the funds go to another parish (with M&F PC in line for a grant in the future).
